Saint Pachomius the Great



St. Pachomius was one of the earliest monks (290-348). He wrote a monastic rule, and was the head of a monastic community long before St. Benedict founded a monastic order.

Pachomius had a very practical understanding of holiness connected to humility and patience. He said, “though fasting and prayer be of great merit, yet sickness, suffered with patience, is of much greater merit.” He said about humility that “it is much better to be one among a crowd of a thousand people and to possess a little humility, than to be a man living in the cave of a hyena alone in pride.” He exemplifies this reality that bearing patiently the cross we are given is always more fruitful than the walking with a cross of our choosing. Let us ask the Lord to bear fruit in the midst of our lives in those difficulties and suffering we face by bearing fruit through humility and patience.
